Babcock's Study of the Impact of a Full Cost Recovery Diesel Fuel Tax on Water Carrier Market Share

- 1. Compute the increase in barge cost of a 100 percent cost recovery diesel fuel tax
- 2. Assume barge prices increase by the increase in barge costs
- 3. Estimate the following equation:

Barge Tonnage = f(Barge Price, Rail Price, Exports, Industrial Production).

- 4. Estimate barge tonnage without the tax
- 5. Estimate barge tonnage with the tax
- 6. Compute the difference between (4) and (5)

Result: Only 4 to 5 percent of barge tonnage would be diverted to rail transport since the demand for barge transport is price inelastic.
