

ELECTION RULES CHEAT-SHEET

DISTRUBUTED MATERIALS

(T-Shirts, Buttons, Stickers)

- Must be distributed in person by individuals—mass mailing or indiscriminate scattering is prohibited.
- Cannot be distributed in parking areas.
- Campaign materials cannot be left unattended.
- Can only be placed on personal property.

E-MAIL AND DIGITAL MESSAGING

- Campaign messages cannot be sent to University Listservs or group messages of academic or advising nature.
- Social media accounts must be registered before being used for campaign purposes.

CHALKING

- No chalking:
 - On Stairs
 - On the upper terrace of Bosco Plaza
 - Within 30ft of building entrances
 - Within 50ft of residence halls
- No “Liquid chalk” or permanent/semi-permanent material.

TABLING

- Must be set up through the Elections Commissioner.
- Must be staffed at all times when in use.
- Ballots cannot be cast within 20ft of a campaign table.

POSTERS

- Cannot be larger than 16” x 22”.
- Can only be attached to bulletin boards, trees, and dorm room doors (with resident permission).
- If outside, must be on cardstock and secured on all corners.
- Cannot overlay another poster.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Campaigns cannot solicit support from academic departments, faculty, or staff.
- No campaign activity may disturb or interrupt a class.
- Campaigns may not remove the campaign materials of other candidates.
- All campaign actions/materials are prohibited in Student Governing Association (SGA) meetings/messaging and the Student Programs and Involvement (SPI) Offices.

All campaign materials must be removed by 7:00p.m. on Thursday, February 22nd.
