

Pre-arrival Online Graduate English Support courses

Online versions of [DAS 176](#) (Reading), [DAS 177](#) (Writing), and [DAS 178](#) (Listening) will be offered April 6-May 29, 2020 for students eligible for admission to graduate programs for Fall 2020 who have iBT TOEFL or IELTS scores that are close to those needed to meet the English Proficiency requirement.

Since TOEFL and IELTS testing are currently disrupted due to the COVID-19 outbreak, these courses allow students the opportunity to improve their English and demonstrate proficiency by earning grades of B or above in these courses prior to their arrival on campus.

Parameters:

1. Students must be admissible to a graduate department (vetted and approved except for English for fall 2020 semester or spring 2020 semester).
2. Students must have passed (20 IBT or 6.5 IELTS) one area (Writing OR Reading OR Speaking and Listening with the other scores as 16-29 IBT or 6.0 IELTS (see chart above).
3. Students can enroll in 1-2 courses
4. Courses will begin April 6 and end May 29, with results to the Graduate School by June 5.
5. Students must pass ALL courses with grades of B or A to be eligible to progress to their graduate degree program.

Cost per course: \$1566.00 (tuition – 3 credits, Global campus fees, proctoring fees and books)
