

# Minor in English

An English minor complements a wide variety of majors throughout the university, and offers excellent preparation for pre-professional majors, secondary education licensure, graduate school, and any employment that values excellent communication skills. At K-State you can choose one of three 18-hour emphases: literature, writing, or children's and young adult literature and culture.

To declare an English minor, go to 108 English/Counseling Services.

  - One American or British survey course ..... 3 hours
  - Four writing courses ENGL 300 or above..... 12 hours  
 - One must be numbered 600 or above
- TOTAL: 18 hours**
