### Self Inspection Checklist

hand tools?

Self-inspection is essential if you are to know where probable hazards exist and whether they are under control. Each month there will be a featured topic. This month is hand tools and equipment.

#### ☐ Are appropriate safety glasses, face HAND TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT shields, etc., used while using hand ☐ Are all tools and equipment (both tools or equipment that might produce company and employee-owned) used at flying materials or be subject to the workplace in good condition? breakage? ☐ Are hand tools, such as chisels, ☐ Are jacks checked periodically to punches, etc., which develop ensure they are in good operating mushroomed heads during use, condition? reconditioned or replaced as necessary? ☐ Are tool handles wedged tightly into the heads of all tools? ☐ Are broken or fractured handles on hammers, axes and similar equipment ☐ Are tool cutting edges kept sharp so the tool will move smoothly without replaced promptly? binding or skipping? ☐ Are worn or bent wrenches replaced? ☐ Are tools stored in a dry, secure ☐ Are appropriate handles used on files location where they cannot be and similar tools? tampered with? ☐ Are employees aware of hazards ☐ Is eye and face protection used when caused by faulty or improperly used driving hardened or tempered studs or

nails?
