Appendix R: Template Course Data Sheet Instructions

Department: Fill in name of department. The department head should sign and date.

Contact Person: Person the college curriculum committee should contact if they need additional information.

Subject: Enter the appropriate course prefix.

Course Number: Choose any available number between 490-499.

Course Short Title: "Undergraduate Research Experience"

Effective term for request action: Fill in term and year you want to start offering the course.

Rationale: "Record and, as appropriate, give credit to students participating in undergraduate research."

Impact: There should be no impact on other departments. If somehow offering this course will impact another department, the standard, non-expedited, course addition process must be used.

Subject: Same as above Number: Same as above

Short Title (Description): "Undergrad Research Experience"

Long Course Title: "Undergraduate Research Experience"

Course Description (including course components and time dedicated to them (rec, lec, lab, etc.)): "Open to students pursuing undergraduate research projects. Requires consent of instructor."

Credit Hours/Units: "Variable 0-3 hours"

Grading Basis: Select the grading basis you wish. Note that this is a course for "experience" and so does not require completion of a project. In particular, it is not appropriate to give incompletes until a project is finished, as is often done in graduate research courses. As such, a Credit/No Credit option is often appropriate, however, the course may be graded if the department and college feel that is the best choice.

Repeat for Credit: "This is a repeated course." However, since the prerequisite requires consent of instructor, departments may limit repetitions by withholding consent.

K-State 8: "No"

Terms Offered: It would be advisable to select "Fall, Spring, and Summer"

Course Titles: "Title May Not Vary" This option is required to enable easy tabulation of the number of students pursuing undergraduate research by searching for the common title.

Academic Group: Specify College. The expedited approval process is specifically geared for courses offered within a particular college. To create an interdisciplinary undergraduate research course, use the standard non-expedited process.

Academic Career: "UGRD (000-799)"

Enrollment Requirement Group: "Required Pre-requisite: Consent of Instructor"

Other Requirements: Enter any additional requirements here. Typically there will be none since you can control student background through consent of instructor, but departments may choose to add requirements if they wish to inform students of necessary background to begin undergraduate research.

Components: Select the component(s) of the course. You will select the component "RSH = Research." However, additional components may be included.

Will one or more of the sections in this course be offered as distance education: Typically NO, even if the student goes off-campus during the research experience. However, some departments might find a distance option appropriate. Be sure to make contact with Global Campus if you wish to offer a section through distance education.
