Concern that the language may encourage someone NOT to file a report, especially if they do not understand the process. Response: further down in the paragraph it states that support and advocacy is confidential. The language means that the OIE will act on the complaint. The form for submitting provides more information so the person is well informed.

Gonzalez points out that this language helps clarify and educate faculty too.

Question: why not delete the "non-confidential" adjective for report. Response: this language makes it consistent with PPM 3010.

In chat idea shared... perhaps test the language with students to get feedback. Response: the group that developed the language included student representation.

Lott: this statement supports other PPMs. Providing is syllabus statement will make it clearer where a student can go to report an issue. Also, refresher for faculty.
