 4 **AND KSU FOUNDATION REGARDING ALL IN**
 5 **FOR K-STATE 2021**

 8 **WHEREAS,** The Kansas State University Student Governing Association (KSU SGA) values the
 9 efforts of Faculty, Staff, and Administrators in reducing the costs of textbooks and class
 10 materials for students;

11
 12 **WHEREAS,** KSU SGA has a history of endorsing and working with programs to do so, such as
 13 through supporting the Open/Alternative Textbook Initiative;

14
 15 **WHEREAS,** KSU SGA passed Resolution 19/20/63: Opposition to TopHat and other Costly
 16 Educational Platforms on February 6, 2020, in order to raise attention regarding the
 17 unpredictable costs of and student displeasure for classroom response and online
 18 textbook systems;

 20 **WHEREAS,** On March 24, 2021, the KSU Foundation held the second All In for K-State event: a 24
 21 hour period of philanthropic giving towards a single goal;

 23 **WHEREAS,** The All In event was focused around raising funds for Textbooks 2.0, a rebranding of the
 24 Open/Alternative Textbook Initiative;

 26 **WHEREAS,** On the day of All In, the KSU Foundation raised more than \$500,000, an increase of over
 27 \$180,000 from their previous All In event and enough to save students at least \$5 million
 28 yearly in textbook costs into the future; and

 30 **WHEREAS,** The money raised will be distributed to professors to create open and alternative
 31 textbooks at a meeting of the Open/Alternative Textbook Initiative Review Committee on
 32 April 29, 2021.

 36 **SECTION 1.** The Kansas State University Student Governing Association (KSU SGA) commends the
 37 members of the Open/Alternative Textbook Initiative, staff of the KSU Foundation, and
 38 donors to All In for supporting this initiative to reduce the costs of textbooks for students.

 40 future.
