Such a boot screen on computers in university labs and Info. Commons might be appropriate, but every instance that "...gains access to a K-State Computer" would imply every computer owned by the university would have to have a boot screen installed and would not apply to other computers that use K-State resources, but are not owned by the university. To be more effective something along the lines of license agreement that students, faculty, etc. would need to accept every time they changed their eID would be more effective and comprehensive.
