- Axio Sunset and K-State Online Updates Scott Finkeldei
  - Sunset of AXIO went well. Scott reports that is his office is getting about 2 to 3 requests a week for data, which is very manageable. It was also reported that a new Universal Design Online content Inspection Tool, UDolt to assist with working towards making Canvas courses 503 compliant.
- Phishing Rebecca Gould
  - Some stats were shared with the group. In January 2016, there were 60 phishing scams reported resulting in 9 compromised accounts. A compromised account means hackers were successful in getting a K-Stater to give up their eID and password. In January 2017, there were 355 phishing scams reported (but only 67 were unduplicated reports) resulting in 313 compromised accounts.

As of February 7th, there were 26 unduplicated scams with 54 compromised accounts.

There will continue to be efforts to educate individuals on how to avoid a phishing scam. Articles in K-State Today, a new video for New Student orientation and enrollment...Training was created students, there is already existing employee training
