## MINUTES KSU Faculty Senate Committee on University Planning Thursday, November 5, 3:30 pm Union 205

Present: Graham, Keller, Bloodgood, Vontz, Hohn, Martini, Honey, Watts, Collins, Cates, and Henry.

- 1. Chair Tom Vontz called the meeting to order at 3:30 pm.
- 2. Vontz began the meeting with announcements:
  - Vontz reported that Ben Champion, Director of Sustainability, will attend the December meeting to discuss the Report of the Sustainability Taskforce.
  - Vontz reported that the Committee on Governmental Relations had met and was beginning to generate some ideas. In particular, Vontz recognized the students' plan to pair KSU students with a member of the legislature to tell them about the great things happening at KSU.
  - Vontz encouraged FSCOUP members to share ideas with him about strategies to educate members of the legislature and other representatives.
- 3. Vontz thanked the committee for their hard work in categorizing budget ideas.
- 4. Vontz opened the floor for discussion of how to proceed with synthesizing individual lists into one list from FSCOUP. The committee discussed the following points:
  - What should be done with bad ideas? Should we leave them off the list entirely? Will we be embarrassed if we left these on our list?
    - After some discussion, the committee decided that it was best for us to leave all ideas on the list. We were asked to perform a specific function that did not include removing ideas.
  - How can a real cost-benefit analysis be conducted?
    - After some discussion, the committee recognized that some that the cost-benefit analysis of some ideas would be more certain than others.
  - For those ideas that involve multiple departments/units/colleges, who will arrange meetings between these entities to discuss ideas?
    - Chair Vontz said that he would bring this to the attention of the administration.
  - Is there even 15 million dollars worth of savings or revenue generation in these ideas?
- 5. After some discussion, the committee asked Vontz to employ the following system in synthesizing the lists:
  - All ideas that have been identified on any list as a "1" will be a "1" on the synthesized list.
  - If an idea has been labeled a "2" or a "3," it will be listed as a "2."
