- 1. Martin Seay called meeting to order
- 2. Updates
  - a. Meeting with consultants in the spring
  - b. Send email update to Martin/Rebecca on CCOP language update
- 3. Eric Erickson Facilities Presentation (VP for Administration and Finance)
  - c. Biggest challenges: aging infrastructure and underutilization of spaces on campus
    - From 2020 assessment, majority of buildings rate C or lower
    - Backlog of deferred maintenance is \$430 million
    - KBOR evaluation found classrooms are being utilized 44% of the time and have a target of 67%
  - d. Solutions
    - Kansas legislature provided \$10 million dedicated to 5 demolition projects on campus (increases space utilization percentage)
    - Legislature awarded \$35 million system-wide that is a 1:1 match for agricultural projects (19 in total)
  - e. Goals
- Demonstrate to KBOR and legislature that if funding is provided, it can be deployed efficiently and effectively to better the university
- f. New Building Plans
  - \$25 million provided by state for agricultural-related initiatives
  - \$100 million available for funding (3:1 match) for other projects
- g. New Master Plan
  - Late spring 2023 through summer 2024 after strategic plan is completed to ensure cohesion
- 2. Follow-Up
  - a. Discuss with Executive Leadership about FSCOUP role in KBOR gen ed changes
