- 4. Co-chair Berumen presented information on the Community of Connections DEIB (PPT slides). That group wants to meet with/collaborate with JEDAII, and is student-focused with the goal of creating a database and mission to bridge all DEIB initiatives across Kansas.
- 5. We will need to decide on a meeting day/time and in-person, virtual, or hybrid
  - a. LaVerne Bitsie-Baldwin commented on the importance of in-person meetings to develop relationships and build community within the committee.

- b. The majority of members in attendance indicated availability for the first and third Tuesday afternoons of the month.
- 6. Tanya Gonzalez summarized current and upcoming university initiatives
  - a. The US multicultural overlay will move forward in the spring (2023), after VP DEIB selection.
  - b. Racial healing and transformation work is ongoing, Dr. Gonzalez was a part of a group from K-State that attended a workshop this summer and she suggested that the head of student union would be a good invited guest for an upcoming JEDAII meeting.
- 7. Julie Yu put forward an announcement Honoring and Celebrating National Hispanic Heritage Month Sept. 15 to Oct. 15.
