    - 2. When results first came out there were only 2 groups faculty and everyone else. Once they broke down the "everyone else" group they found there were significant differences.
    - 3. PSA wants the top 6 from each group
  - iii. Would like new survey to have some changes
    - 1. Should professional staff have a shorter survey?
    - 2. Look at redesigning the survey for job satisfaction
    - 3. Would need a survey expert to design the survey
      - a. Last time there was a consultant hired, but the reality is, there are already experts on campus that do that
  - iv. At one point there was discussion to have KBOR do a survey for all of the institutions

  - ii. FSCOT want to work on career ladder and position descriptions/titles
  - iii. Need to do something to clean-up the career ladders
    - 1. Ask HCS if we can see "the next three steps" where are we going?

  - 2. Tuition waiver across state institutions (reciprocity) if programs are not offered at the home institution (i.e. MILS only offered at Emporia State)
