Call to Order

- 1. Approval of February 7th minutes & 21st minutes
 - a. Approved

2. New Business

- a. COLA proposal
 - i. Proposal was sent to administration to review
 - ii. Using the % increases the pay gap
 - iii. Proposing is to get same amount (flat rate) and based on FTE rate (e.g., 0.8 vs 1.0)
 - Have merit be based on %
 - KBOR may mandate a specific way to allocate
 - iv. Eliminates impact on those on lower pay scales
 - v. Salina had similar concerns
 - vi. Arrange it to resolve this going forward
 - vii. Seems to be consensus of PSA

 - i. Vote to cancel 3.21.23 meeting

- a. HCS follow-up with answers to PSA questions regarding the ineligible to rehire list policy

 - v. Applies to faculty and staff
 - vi. There will not be an appeal once on the list
 - Being on the list will only happen after being placed on the list.

<u>Retention</u> – Ag and HHS had issues with faculty retention, and staff had retention issues that were > than national average. Some of the issues were due to COVID.

The new budget model does not hold position lines anymore, so may not be comparing apples – apples.

If a position is no longer held, it may appear that the position is not needed (since it is not held/open) and budget was re-allocated.
