Federal guidelines for higher education awards (currently OMB A-21, A-110 & A-133) are merging with five other circulars into one comprehensive document called **Uniform Guidance (UG)**.

All new federal awards (and incremental funding of existing awards) issued after 12/26/14 will be subject to the new agency terms & conditions and Uniform Guidance. Older awards will likely be a mix of old and new rules depending on how each agency handles any modifications to older segments of funding.

In an effort to track which awards are subject to new Uniform Guidance and which are still subject to prior OMB Circulars, we added a field in the Oracle Financial Information System (FIS). To see this field, log-in to Oracle, select Grants, enter award #, select Award Inquiry, select Terms and Conditions tab.
