General Background

- Nation's first operational land-grant university under the 1862 Morrill Act
 - Generations of success for 150 years
- Three-campus system
 - Main/Vet Med Manhattan Campus (1863)
 - Salina Campus (1991)
 - Olathe Campus (2011)
- General info:
 - 24,378 students
 - 1,312 faculty
 - 60+ University Distinguished Professors
 - \$137.4 million (U.S.) external research funds

State Outreach

- KSRE serves all 105 Kansas counties
 - More than 20 agricultural research centers and experiment stations
- One of the nation's most military-inclusive public universities
 - Use research, educational programs and outreach to serve and support military members, families, and veterans

Global Research

- Center of Excellence for Emerging and Zoonotic Animal Diseases (CEEZAD)
 - Emerging animal and zoonotic diseases
 - Strengths: vaccine development, detection, epidemiology, outreach
 - Biosecurity Research Institute (BRI) accelerates research
- James R. Macdonald Laboratory
 - International leader in atomic, molecular and optical physics research
 - \$2.5 million annually from Department of Energy
 - Program ranked 13th best in the nation
- Konza Prairie Biological Station
 - More than 8,600 acres of native tallgrass prairie
 - Long-term ecological research, education and prairie conservation

Biosecurity Research Institute

- Biosafety level-3 and biosafety level-3 agriculture facility
- Study high-consequence pathogens that threaten human health, animal health and food supply
- Research springboard for National Bio and Agro-Defense Facility (NBAF)

FY 2014 and FY 2015 Budget

- We support the Governor's budget recommendation
 - Architecture, Planning & Design construction and remodel
 - FY 14 \$1.0 million
 - FY 15 \$1.5 million
- Continued support for strategic initiatives
 - Veterinary Medicine improvement/expansion
 - \$5.0 million
 - NBAF launch research
 - \$5.0 million
 - Engineering expansion program
 - \$3.5 million
 - Animal health research
 - \$5.0 million
 - Rehabilitation and repair
 - \$35.0 million (system-wide)

Challenges

- · Retain best and brightest faculty & staff
 - Now in year five of no state-funded salary increases
- Keep tuition affordable
 - Focus on tuition & fees
 - Help students manage debt from loans
- Maintain aging buildings
 - Oldest physical plant in state
 - 261 state-owned buildings to maintain

- 2+2 articulation agreements
 - All community colleges in Kansas
- Engineering initiative with KU and WSU
 - Plans for expansion moving forward
- Johnson Center for Basic Cancer Research
 - Supports KU national cancer institute
- Wind energy research
- Olathe campus corporate partnerships
 - U.S.-China Center for Animal Health
 - International Food Safety and Animal Health Institute
 - Urban Water Institute
- Salina campus collaboration and research with business and military
 - One of first two universities to offer remotely piloted aircraft systems program

Selected Accomplishments

- Record enrollment of 24,378 students
 - Most diverse freshman class ever
- 2010-2011 bachelor's graduates
 - 92% of graduates employed or pursuing further education
 - 71% employed in Kansas or Kansas City metro
- Attracted university's first National Academy of Sciences member
- Support of targeted state initiatives
 - Engineering
 - Graduate programs ranked in top 100
 - Architecture
 - Three programs ranked in top 6 nationally
 - Veterinary Medicine
- IT efficiency initiative

Selected Accomplishments

- Named top university for professional sales education
 - By Sales Education Foundation
- Center for the Advancement of Entrepreneurship
 - Nationally recognized among university-based centers
- Student teams win national competitions
 - Crops Team wins fourth straight national title
 - Financial planning team wins national title
 - Student robotics team wins sixth consecutive national title
- Genetic advancements
 - Sequencing wheat genome and pig genome
