### WRITING CENTER

#### Asynchronous eTutoring

Submit writing Monday-Wednesday and receive written feedback within 48 hours. Consultants do not edit student work but respond to issues of clarity, organization and development of content.

#### Synchronous Online Video Sessions

"Live Video Tutoring" allows student writers with the technology to support video conferencing to upload their document and meet with a writing consultant online in a 30-45 minute video chat.
