Transcript Ordering at End of Fall 2017 Term

Final grade posting for the fall term finishes late evening on Tuesday, December 19, 2017. Transcripts ordered Urgent Processing or Hold for Pick-up after 1:00 p.m. on Friday, December 22, 2017 through Monday, January 1, 2018, will not be processed until Tuesday, January 2, 2018, when K-State reopens for business. To secure a transcript at the end of the fall 2017 term with your final grades included, first check your Student Center in KSIS the morning of Wednesday, December 20, 2017, to verify that your fall grades have posted, then order your transcript through your Student Center or Other Academic tiles in KSIS. Please check, prior to Wednesday, December 20, 2017, for any holds that may exist in your Student Center in KSIS, and remember that most holds must be cleared prior to ordering a transcript. *Students graduating Fall 2017 or who will not be enrolled in Spring 2018, will have until December 29, 2017, to order transcripts at no charge.* If you have any questions about securing a transcript at the end of the fall 2017 term, then please contact KSUtrans@ksu.edu prior to Friday, December 22, 2017.
