The Graduate Student Health Insurance for the summer 2017 semester is open for enrollment starting May 1, 2017 and closes June 30, 2017. To be eligible for the

reduced premium, the graduate student must be enrolled in 3 or more credit hours during the summer semester.

### **Transcript Ordering from K-State**

To secure a transcript at the end of the Spring 2017 term with your final grades included, first check the Student Center in KSIS the morning of Wednesday, May 17 to verify that your spring grades have posted and then proceed to order your transcript through your Student Center in KSIS. Students graduating in Spring 2017 term, or who will not be enrolled in fall 2017 term have until Friday, May 26 to order transcripts at no charge. ### **Career and postdoc opportunities available**

### **Fulbright U.S. Student Grant**

The Fulbright U.S. Student Grant can fully fund a year of research abroad for graduate students. U.S. citizens from all disciplines are eligible to apply, and grants are available to over 140 different countries. The campus deadline for submitting an application is September 1, 2017. Complete applications are due to Jim Hohenbary, Fulbright Program Adviser, in 215 Fairchild by that date. Research applicants are commonly required to have identified a host country affiliation as part of the application process. Therefore, interested students are encouraged to speak with Mr. Hohenbary before the end of the Spring 2017 semester to learn more about the application process and discuss the process of securing an appropriate letter of affiliation.
