K-State has campuses in Manhattan, Olathe and Salina - home of the Aerospace and Technology Campus - as well as K-State Online, which serves distance education students around the world. Called the "Silicon Valley for biodefense" because of its leadership in food safety and security and agrodefense, K-State is home to four Feed the Future Innovation Labs, an initiative by the U.S. Agency for International Development to increase food production in nations with limited resources. The university also is home to the Biosecurity Research Institute, a biosafety level-3 facility devoted to comprehensive infectious disease research and training. Adjacent to the Manhattan campus, USDA's National Bio and Agro-Defense Facility, a world-class science facility for large animal agricultural research, training and diagnostics, completed construction in May 2022.

Total research efforts at Kansas State University have led to more than 335 patents to date. The university has more than 90 research centers, including the 8,600-acre Konza Prairie Biological Station and the Johnson Cancer Research Center. About Our Ceremonies

University mace

The Kansas State University mace made its debut in September 2009 at the inauguration of Kirk H. Schulz as the university's 13th president. A mace is a decorative symbol of office and typically carried at the front of academic processions. Designed by Tom Boley, a 1970 K-State alumnus, the mace is made from a purple wood called purpleheart and a light-colored maple.

Academic dress

The history of academic dress dates to medieval European universities of the 12th century. Universities in the U.S. have standardized academic dress so its features are common and uniform throughout the country.

The gown — At K-State, gowns are black and typically made of synthetic material or worsted wool. The pattern varies with the degree held: open sleeves

for the bachelor's degree; long, closed sleeves with slits for the hands for the master's degree; and round, bell sleeves for the doctoral degree.

The hood — Students receiving graduate degrees wear hoods. The master's hood is shorter than the doctoral hood and lacks the panels of the doctoral hood. Hoods are lined with the colors of the university; K-State's lining is purple with two inverted chevrons. The binding or edging of the hood is the color pertaining to the subject of the degree.

The caps — All bachelor's and master's degree candidates wear a black mortarboard. Doctoral students may wear a mortarboard or a soft velvet tam with either six or eight sides. The tams can be dark blue or black for Doctor of Philosophy candidates and light blue for Doctor of Education candidates. Doctor of Veterinary Medicine candidates wear a black mortarboard. Tassel color for all degree candidates depends on the degree and/or degree field.

Graduation honors

Bachelor's degree candidates who are earning graduation honors from Kansas State University wear a purple-and-white honor cord on the left shoulder of their commencement gowns. Honors are awarded based on their K-State grade point averages. Eligible students also must have completed a minimum of 60 undergraduate hours at K-State, with at least 42 undergraduate hours in graded courses at K-State.

K-State graduation honors: Summa cum laude — For students with a 3.95 or above GPA. Magna cum laude — For students with a 3.85-3.949 GPA. Cum laude — For students with a 3.75-3.849 GPA.

Note: Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree candidates receive these honors based on courses completed in the professional program. For the purpose of the commencement ceremony, unofficial graduation honors are recognized for bachelor's degree candidates who possess the required K-State cumulative GPA prior to the start of the semester in which they plan to participate in the commencement ceremony, and who have completed or are currently enrolled in enough credit hours to satisfy the credit hour requirements.

Speaker



David Delker earned an associate degree in electronic engineering technology from Kansas Technical Institute, which is now K-State Salina, in 1973. After working several years as an electronic engineering technician in industry, he earned a bachelor's degree in technical education

and a master's degree in electrical engineering at Oklahoma State University.

Delker joined the Kansas Technical Institute as an assistant professor in 1979 and served on the faculty until 1983 when he accepted a position at the Kansas State University College of Engineering in Manhattan. He taught on the Manhattan campus until 1993 when he returned to the Salina campus after it merged with K-State. Delker led the electronic engineering technology program from 1993 until 1998 when he became department head of engineering technology. He served in that position until 2004 when he became associate dean of academics for the campus. He retired as associate dean and professor emeritus in 2014.

The Kansas Technical Institute recognized Delker for his teaching by naming him the first recipient of the Marchbanks Award for Teaching Excellence in 1983. He served his profession as a program evaluator for the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology and evaluated 18 electronic and computer engineering technology programs across the country. Throughout his career, he established a strong applied research and service record. He worked as a consultant in electronic instrumentation and digital systems development with several companies, particularly in fluid power and agricultural system design.

Delker's service to the university is extensive and includes serving on the K-State Faculty Senate, Academic Affairs Committee, the Committee on Academic Policies and Procedures, and the General Education Task Force. For several years he chaired the 40-person committee of academic and administrative stakeholders that designed and implemented the K-State student information system, KSIS. He chaired the team that developed the curriculum management system for the university and led student advising, faculty development and assessment programs for the K-State Salina campus.

For his distinguished career, the K-Salina Aerospace and Technology Campus selected Delker as its 2022 Alumni Fellow.

Delker and his wife, Shawn, are active volunteers in the 4-H program in Saline County and statewide. They both continue to teach and mentor students, although now the academic subjects include — in addition to electronics — woodworking, photography and visual art. The Delkers are parents of three K-State graduates: Ryan in 2001, Collin in 2003 and Kelsey in 2009.

Kansas Board of Regents



Wint Winter

Winter was appointed to the Kansas Board of Regents in June 2021 by Gov. Laura Kelly. A fifth-generation resident of Lawrence, he graduated in 1975 from the University of Kansas where he was a varsity football letterman. He then attended KU Law School, graduating fourth in his class in 1978.

Winter has been a partner in the Lawrence law firm of Stevens & Brand since 1978, serving as managing partner from 1995-1999. His law practice has been varied and has included business and personal injury litigation, real estate development law, bankruptcy, divorce law and estate planning.

He began a career in public service when he became Douglas County counselor from 1998-2000. From 1982 to 1992, Winter served in the Kansas Senate where he was vice chairman of the Ways & Means Committee and chairman of the Judiciary Committee. He also was chairman of the Economic Development Committee for the National Conference of State Legislators. In 1986, he was named by KS Magazine as one of the Top 10 legislators in Kansas.

While in the Kansas Senate, Winter led the effort to enact a criminal sentencing guidelines system, successfully led the fight against enactment of the death penalty, introduced the sexual predator bill and gained a reputation as an advocate for neglected and abused children. In 1990 he received the annual Leadership Award for Outstanding Contributions to Children from the University of Kansas School of Social Welfare. In 1994 he unsuccessfully ran for the Republican nomination for Kansas attorney general.

In 2000, Winter became executive vice president and general counsel of Peoples Inc., the Winter family bank holding company with 25 branches in Kansas, Colorado and New Mexico. In 2002 he became president and CEO of Peoples Bank in Kansas and led the merger of two banks in Kansas and one in New Mexico. When Peoples Inc. was sold on Jan. 1, 2018, it had nearly 40 branches in 11 states with nearly \$1 billion in assets and nearly 1,000 employees.

After selling the family business, Winter returned to part-time law practice in Lawrence. He serves with many charitable organizations and on several nonprofit boards. He was a member of the St. John Parish Counsel and has served in roles as diverse as chairman of the Sexual Abuse Review Board of the Capuchin Franciscan Province of Mid-America and a member of the board of directors of the Kansas Banking Commission. He also served as chairman of Save Kansas Coalition Inc., a nonprofit political education group that advanced centrist policies and helped reverse radical tax policies in Kansas.

He and his wife, Mary, a former math and religion teacher at St. John School, have three daughters and eight grandchildren.





Mark Becker

Mark Becker is president of the Association of Public and Land-grant Universities, or APLU, a membership organization that fosters a community of university leaders collectively working to advance the mission of public research universities in the U.S., Canada and Mexico.

Prior to leading APLU, Becker spent more than three decades at many of the different types of universities that comprise APLU's membership, having served as a postdoctoral fellow, professor, dean, provost and president at flagships, land-grants and urban-serving institutions. Most recently, Becker served as president of Georgia State University from January 2009 to August 2021. During his tenure, Georgia State was one of the fastest growing research universities in the nation as sponsored awards more than doubled, and the university became a widely recognized national leader in the introduction of innovative programs and initiatives to foster student success. Under Becker's leadership, the university became one of the most diverse universities in the U.S., led the country in eliminating disparities in graduation rates based on race, ethnicity or income, and was first in the nation among nonprofit institutions in graduating Black students.

Becker has been a principal investigator on research funded by the National Institutes of Health and by the National Science Foundation, and he was a co-investigator on projects supported by the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Aetna Inc. and Quality Care Research Fund. Becker has received numerous awards and recognitions, including being named one of America's 10 most innovative university presidents by Washington Monthly in 2015, the Academic Leadership Award from the Carnegie Corporation of New York in 2017, and the Hesburgh Award for Leadership Excellence in Higher Education from TIAA Institute in 2019. He is a fellow of the American Statistical Association and the American Association for the Advancement of Science.

Becker attended Harford Community College in Maryland and earned his bachelor's degree in mathematics from Towson State University. He earned a doctorate in statistics from Pennsylvania State University.

As one of the most renowned international research leaders in insect molecular physiology, Yoonseong Park's research focuses not solely on insect pest species but also on other arthropod pest species. His group was the first to document the neuropeptidergic signaling system in multiple

arthropod species. Park's group also identified several new insect neuropeptides and their corresponding receptors. Park's research has been supported by 31 grants and contracts totaling more than \$7 million from various agencies. He has authored 121 journal publications and has given 247 research presentations and 89 invited talks.

Park has also made a significant contribution to graduate education at K-State, teaching several graduate courses, including Insects Physiology, Insect Anatomy and Histology, and Molecular Entomology Laboratory. He has mentored 10 postdoctoral fellows or visiting scientists and 25 undergraduate students. His devoted mentoring is evident — more than 70% of his students continue their careers in science as faculty members or research scientists. Many of his students and postdoctoral researchers have now become national or international leaders in their respective careers.

Park earned his doctorate in insect science from the University of Arizona. He joined K-State's entomology department in 2002. His work has been recognized with awards from K-State, including the K-State College of Agriculture Excellence in Graduate Teaching Award in 2013. In 2020, Park was selected as Faculty of the Year by the Entomology Popenoe Club at K-State.



Hans Coetzee

As an internationally recognized scholar, Hans Coetzee has made high-impact contributions to improving the health and welfare of farm animals. His laboratory developed drug protocols that have positively impacted the welfare of more than 10 million calves that experience painful management procedures

each year. Recently, Coetzee's research discovered methods to reduce pain at processing, which affects more than 100 million piglets each year, by delivering pain relief medications through milk from the sow to the piglets. Coetzee has been successful in securing more than \$21.5 million in research funding. He has authored and co-authored 209 peer-reviewed manuscripts with more than 6,879 citations. For perspective, since the start of his academic career, he averages one publication per month and one million dollars in funding each year.

His contributions to graduate education at K-State include establishing the Anatomy and Physiology Graduate Assistantship Program. This program provides an opportunity for new graduate students to rotate through research laboratories using departmental funding for their first year of the program, resulting in a threefold increase in the number of doctoral students enrolled in the physiology program since 2018. Coetzee has mentored 28 graduate students — 10 as a major professor and 18 as a committee member. Coetzee earned his doctorate in veterinary microbiology from Iowa State University in 2005. In 2022, he received the title of university distinguished professor, a lifetime title representing the highest honor at Kansas State University awarded to faculty. Coetzee is nationally and internationally recognized for his work, including being the youngest recipient of the American Veterinary Medical Association Animal Welfare Award in 2017.

Temple Grandin is a distinguished professor of animal science at Colorado State University and a designer of livestock handling facilities and systems that are used by many companies around the world, including the Kansas State University College of Veterinary Medicine. She has been instrumental in

implementing animal welfare auditing programs that are used by McDonald's, Wendy's, Whole Foods and other corporations.

She earned a bachelor's degree at Franklin Pierce College and a master's degree in animal science at Arizona State University. Grandin received her doctorate in animal science from the University of Illinois in 1989. Today she teaches courses on livestock behavior and facility design at Colorado State University and consults with the livestock industry on facility design, livestock handling and animal welfare.

She has appeared on television shows such as "20/20," "48 Hours," "CNN Larry King Live," "Prime Time Live," "60 Minutes" and many programs in other countries. She has been featured in People Magazine, the New York Times, Forbes, U.S. News and World Report, Discover Magazine and the New York Times book review. Time Magazine named her one of the 100 most influential people in 2010. Interviews with Grandin have been broadcast on National Public Radio, and she has a 2010 TED talk, "The World Needs All Kinds of Minds."

Grandin has authored more than 400 articles in scientific journals and livestock periodicals on animal handling, welfare and facility design. Her life story has also been made into an award-winning HBO movie, "Temple Grandin," starring Claire Danes.

Her books include "Thinking in Pictures," "Livestock Handling and Transport" and "The Autistic Brain." Two of Grandin's books, "Animals in Translation" and "Visual Thinking," have been on the New York Times Bestseller List.

Grandin was inducted into the National Women's Hall of Fame in September 2017.

Traci Brimhall is a professor of English at Kansas State University and the 2023-2026 Poet Laureate of Kansas. She holds a bachelor's degree from Florida State University, a Master of Fine Arts from Sarah Lawrence College and a doctorate from Western Michigan University. She directs the creative writing program

at K-State. Brimhall has authored four poetry collections: "Come the Slumberless to the Land of Nod"; "Saudade"; "Our Lady of the Ruins," selected by Carolyn Forché for the 2011 Barnard Women Poets Prize; and "Rookery," selected by Michelle Boisseau for the 2009 Crab Orchard Series in Poetry First Book Award and a finalist for the ForeWord Book of the Year Award.

Brimhall's poems have appeared in The New Yorker, Poetry, Orion The Believer, The Nation, The New Republic and New York Times Magazine. Her essays have appeared in Georgia Review, The Southern Review, Prairie Schooner, Gulf Coast and Brevity. Her work has also been featured on Poetry Daily, Verse Daily, Best of the Net, PBS Newshour and Best American Poetry 2013 and 2014. She has received the Just Desserts Short Fiction Prize from Passages North, the Annie Dillard Award for Creative Nonfiction from Bellingham Review, the Jane Geske Award for poetry from Prairie Schooner, the Cecil Hemley Award from the Poetry Society of America and a Pushcart Prize.

She received a National Endowment for the Arts Literature Fellowship in Poetry, the Summer Poet in Residence at the University of Mississippi and the Jay C. and Ruth Halls Poetry Fellowship at the Wisconsin Institute for Creative Writing. Other awards for her work include scholarships and fellowships to the Breadloaf Writers' Conference, the Sewanee Writers' Conference, the Kimmel Harding Nelson Center for the Arts, The Writer's Center of Bethesda, Vermont Studio Center, the Disquiet International Literary Program, the Arctic Circle Residency and the SWWIM/Betsy Hotel Residency. Brimhall has received the Karnes Fellowship from Purdue Libraries to research Amelia Earhart's unpublished poems.




