

# About Our Ceremonies

#### University mace

The Kansas State University mace made its debut in September 2009 at the inauguration of Kirk H. Schulz as the university's 13th president. A mace is a decorative symbol of office and typically carried at the front of academic processions. Designed by Tom Boley, a 1970 K-State alumnus, the mace is made from a purple wood called purpleheart and a light-colored maple.

#### Academic dress

The history of academic dress dates to medieval European universities of the 12th century. Universities in the U.S. have standardized academic dress so its features are common and uniform throughout the country.

The gown: K-State undergraduate gowns are purple, and graduate gowns are black. Gowns are typically made of synthetic material or worsted wool. The pattern varies with the degree held: open sleeves for the bachelor's degree; long,

closed sleeves with slits for the hands for the master's degree; and round, bell sleeves for the doctoral degree.

The hood: Students receiving graduate degrees wear hoods. The master's hood is shorter than the doctoral hood and lacks the panels of the doctoral hood. Hoods are lined with the colors of the university; K-State's lining is purple with two inverted chevrons. The binding or edging of the hood is the color pertaining to the subject of the degree.

The caps: All bachelor's candidates wear a purple mortarboard, and master's degree candidates wear a black mortarboard. Doctoral students may wear a mortarboard or a soft velvet tam with either six or eight sides. The tams can be dark blue or black for Doctor of Philosophy candidates and light blue for Doctor of Education candidates. Doctor of Veterinary Medicine candidates wear a black mortarboard. Tassel color for all degree candidates depends on the degree and/or degree field.

Bachelor's degree candidates who are earning graduation honors from Kansas State University wear a purple-and-white honor cord on the left shoulder of their commencement gowns. Honors are awarded based on their K-State grade point averages. Eligible students also must have completed a minimum of 60 undergraduate hours at K-State, with at least 42 undergraduate hours in graded courses at K-State.

#### K-State graduation honors:

Summa cum laude — For students with a 3.95 or above GPA

**Magna cum laude** — For students with a 3.85-3.949 GPA.

Cum laude — For students with a 3.75-3.849 GPA.

Note: Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree candidates receive these honors based on courses completed in the professional program. For the purpose of the commencement ceremony, unofficial graduation honors are recognized for bachelor's degree candidates who possess the required K-State cumulative GPA prior to the start of the semester in which they plan to participate in the commencement ceremony, and who have completed or are currently enrolled in enough credit hours to satisfy the credit hour requirements.

D.J. Johnson

.J. Johnson is a former Kansas State University basketball standout who has built a dynamic career that spans professional basketball, urban planning, real estate and community development. Known for his passion, energy and hustle on the court, the 6-foot-9 center played in the NBA

G League and overseas, showcasing the same drive that made him a fan favorite at K-State.

Beyond basketball, Johnson has pursued his academic and professional ambitions with equal intensity. He earned a master's degree in Regional and Community Planning from K-State's College of Architecture, Planning & Design in the department of landscape architecture and regional & community planning — a milestone he achieved while balancing his professional basketball career. His passion for city planning and economic development led him to work with Shockey Consulting in Overland Park, where he focused on his real estate consulting and urban growth initiatives. He also provided planning services in a consultant capacity for the city of De Soto as it prepared for a \$4 billion investment by Panasonic Energy North America.

In addition to his work in city planning, Johnson has found success as a real estate agent in Kansas City, leveraging his strong network and commitment to helping clients - many of whom share his K-State roots. His expertise extends beyond brokering deals; he specializes in acquiring, restoring and developing properties to revitalize neighborhoods. His work promotes the restoration of core neighborhoods and full-service communities, fostering long-term sustainability and economic growth.

Johnson holds a bachelor's degree in business administration with an emphasis in entrepreneurship from Kansas State University. His business background and planning expertise have made him a leader in urban revitalization, real estate development and community-driven growth.

M. Duane Nellis is an internationally recognized scholar and national higher education leader who served nearly four decades in academia. He is currently president emeritus and a trustee professor at Ohio University.

As president, he guided Ohio University toward strategic pathways designed

to elevate access and inclusion, student success and transformation, research and knowledge discovery in support of vibrant communities, and a sustainable academic enterprise. Nellis also elevated the Ohio University Heritage College of Osteopathic Medicine, strengthening partnerships with the Cleveland Clinic, Ohio Health and the Kettering Foundation. Past roles include president of Texas Tech University and the University of Idaho and dean of the Eberly College of Arts and Sciences at West Virginia University.

Nellis also previously served as provost and senior vice president at Kansas State University. As K-State's provost, Nellis was known for enhancing the learning environment for students through high-technology classrooms and online education.

He helped develop the universitywide honors program and enhanced university entrepreneurism, and his efforts led to the creation of a Commercialization Leadership Council, a Center for Engagement and Community Development and a Center for the Advancement of Entrepreneurship.

He is recognized nationally and internationally for his research that utilizes satellite data and geographic information systems to analyze various dimensions of the Earth's land surface. This research has been funded by more than 50 sources, including NASA and the National Geographic Society. His research has led to more than 160 articles and reports in a wide range of professional journals and more than 20 books and book chapters. Nellis is a fellow of the prestigious American Association for the Advancement of Science, the Explorers Club in New York City and the American Association of Geographers.

Most recently, Nellis served as a member of the executive committee of the Association of Public and Land-Grant Universities Commission on Economic and Community Engagement. He earned a bachelor's degree in earth sciences/ geography at Montana State University and master's and doctoral degrees in geography from Oregon State University. Both universities have recognized Nellis as a distinguished alumnus.

Beth Montelone

eth Montelone, Ph.D., **D**is a professor of biology and the senior associate vice president for research at Kansas State University. She directs the Office of Research Development, which supports and facilitates the research of K-State's faculty, staff and students by helping coordinate multi-investigator

research collaborations, professional development activities and universitywide research initiatives.

Montelone joined K-State's Division of Biology in 1988. Her research focused on DNA repair and mutagenesis. She also worked to increase the participation of underrepresented groups in STEM and improve science education. Her work has been funded by multiple agencies, including the National Science Foundation, the National Institutes of Health, the U.S. Department of Agriculture and the Kansas Health Foundation.

She is currently the principal investigator on a National Science Foundation Engines Development Award to advance economic development by capitalizing on regional expertise in biosecurity, biodefense and biomanufacturing. She also manages all biomanufacturing initiatives for K-State.

Montelone served as associate dean for research in the College of Arts and Sciences from 2004 to 2017. Her responsibilities included research compliance, safety, instructional technology, space planning, renovations and infrastructure. She directed the Faculty Enhancement Program, the Undergraduate Research Award Program and the Student Research Travel Award Program. From 2008 to 2011, she also served as interim research director of the Biosecurity Research Institute and held the Peine Professorship of Biosecurity.

Montelone earned her bachelor's degree in biology from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute and her doctorate in molecular genetics from the University of Rochester, both in New York. She carried out postdoctoral research at the University of Miami School of Medicine and the University of Iowa.

ynthia Kiser Murphey is an accomplished senior executive hospitality leader with more than 30 years of experience in the industry. As one of the first female presidents on the Las Vegas Strip, Murphey has successfully opened four megaresorts, including the world's largest hotel, in multiple jurisdictions,

achieving record business results.

Most recently, Murphey created history by spearheading the reopening of Palms Casino Resort as the first casino resort to be owned and operated by a Native American tribe in Las Vegas. As general manager, Murphey revived the property after a closure due to COVID-19 by hiring more than 2,000 team members while overseeing all operations for gaming, hospitality, and food and beverage for the 766-room casino resort and for Palms Place condominiums. She also created a team member volunteer program, Palms Cares, and donated more than \$2 million to local charities.

Murphey grew up in Kansas City and moved to Las Vegas to study hotel management. She earned bachelor's and master's degrees from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, where she was also a parttime faculty member and adjunct professor. Her tenure on the Las Vegas Strip included multiple leadership positions at MGM Resorts International, including senior vice president of human resources and president and chief operating officer of New York-New York Hotel & Casino. During her time with MGM, Murphey opened three megaresorts, including the world's largest hotel, as a key member of the senior leadership team.

Developing people, strengthening communities and creating an exceptional guest service experience are hallmarks of Murphey's career. While at MGM, she founded one of the gaming industry's first diversity, equity and inclusion initiatives, which trained and certified more than 40,000 "Diversity Champions."
