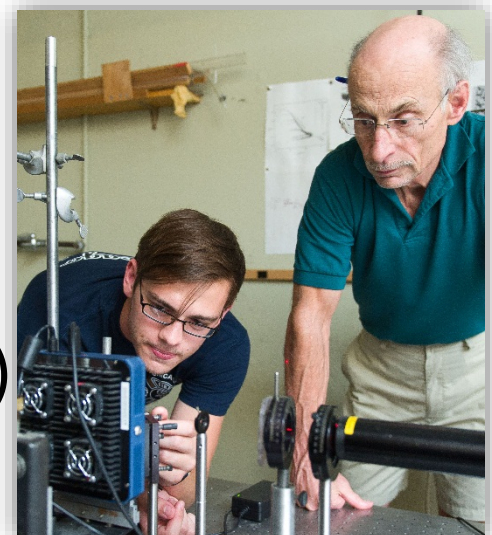


Mission
