## **RE:** Notice to file your Statement of Substantial Interests (SSI)

K.S.A. 46-247 and 46-248 requires all state employees listed as designees by their agency head to file a Statement of Substantial Interests with the Secretary of State annually between April 15th and April 30th. You were listed as a designee by your agency head.

There has been some confusion when filing this form and I hope this information below will provide some clarity.

Although the **University** requires a similar form called "Conflict of Interest" to be completed by staff and members. This form does **not** relieve you of the responsibility to complete the statement of substantial interests form from the Kansas Governmental Ethics Commission, which is different from the University. A statement of substantial interest form must be completed annually between April 15<sup>th</sup> and April 30<sup>th</sup>, for individuals who meet the requirements and is required by state law. Because of the responsibilities associated with your current position, or because you are a faculty member with an annual salary of \$150,000 or more.

Forms will be accepted from April 1 through April 30, 2022. Statutorily forms received after April 30, 2022, may result in a civil penalty per K.S.A. 46-280.

## If you filed prior to April 1, 2022 – it is necessary to resubmit the SSI with a current date.

You may file <u>electronically</u> or by submitting a <u>paper form</u> to the Secretary of State. If you filed electronically last year the system will automatically populate the previous data into this year's form, allowing you to simply update your information and submit it with a current date. We encourage people to file electronically as it simplifies the process in future years for you and assists our office in processing.

The completed SSI form must be received in the Secretary of State's Office no later than **April 30, 2022**. You may submit your form either by mail, fax, or email.
