Fundamental Values of Academic Integrity while Remote Teaching/Learning

Members of the K-State community are expected to promote the 6 fundamental values of academic integrity even in the face of adversity.

> Honesty Trust Fairness Respect Responsibility Courage

What this means:

- Understand that the remote environment may look different. Ask for clarification from your instructor.
- Use university sponsored tutors.
- Remember your own values and act on them.
- Focus on learning the material rather than doing the bare minimum.
- Know what is allowed and not allowed in the assessments for each course (i.e. open book might not mean you can copy and paste information from a website).
- Avoid "help" sites such as Chegg, Coursehear, Studyblue, Studysoup, etc. Posting information or receiving information from them will likely be a violation.
- Say something if you see someone act without integrity. File a report or inform your teacher.

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
