

Organization Chart






Proportional Representation

- 1. Faculty members desired further guidance regarding evaluations during Covid-19 pandemic.
- 2. Faculty member contacted a member of the FS Leadership Council.
- 3. FS Leadership Council member brought idea forward and it was worked on by the appropriate committee.
- 4. FS Leadership Council also discussed the issue with the President and Provost during a scheduled meeting and they were grateful and supportive of these efforts.
- 5. Faculty Affairs worked on appropriate documentation, which was then approved by Faculty Senate and shared with administration.
- 6. Guidance was put in place and is now being utilized.
