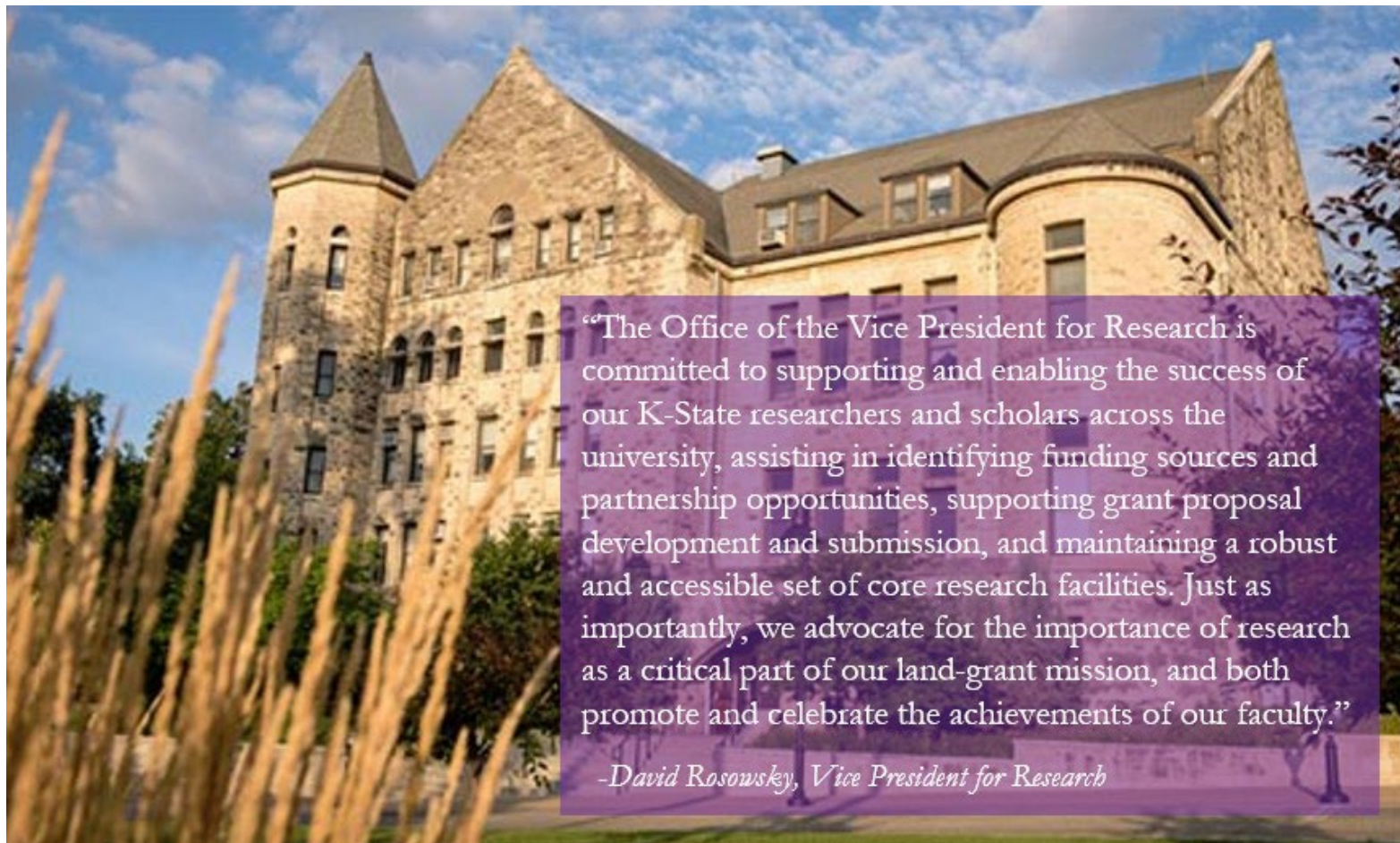

OVPR

The Office of the Vice President for Research administers and promotes the university's research and economic development missions through a variety of supporting offices, services, and dedicated facilities.

FY19 grants/contracts: \$174M; \$219M expenditures

FY20 grants/contracts: \$199M; \$214M expenditures

FY21 grants/contracts: \$207M; \$204M expenditures

FY22 grants/contracts: \$182M;



Includes **one-time**
CARES and HEERF funds;
