

ICC - Super Six Cricket Tournament Rules

1. 6 overs per innings for one match and to be played with a team of 6 each side. (Additional 2 player can be substitute)
2. One player can bowl two overs and other player can one over each, except for the wicket-keeper. Wides and no-balls count as two runs.
3. If five wickets fall before 6 overs are completed, the last remaining batsman bats on with the fifth batsman acting as a runner. He always takes strike. The innings is complete when the sixth wicket falls.
4. Batsmen retire not out on reaching 31 runs. The idea being to reach 36 runs by hitting 6 sixes. A retired batsman can return to the crease after lower-order batsmen either retire or are out.
5. There is No Super Sub play throughout the tournament. A substitute is allowed only to Field. He is not allowed to Bowl and Bat for the match. Umpires and opponent captain must be informed in such event of having a substitute on field.
6. In case of fielder/wicket Keeper substitute, umpire and captain needs to be informed.
7. No LBW and No Leg Byes.
8. A ball is termed as NO-BALL in the following cases: Over-Stepping the Bowling Crease Line (Front), Above the waist is a NO-BALL, one bouncer is allowed per over (Above the shoulder but not above the head), the subsequent bouncing ball will be treated as a No-Ball. If a delivery is bounced above head, it is a Wide and 1st Warning to bowler. The subsequent bouncing ball will be treated as a No-Ball. When the bowler takes of the Bails during the swing action will also result to a No-Ball. All No-Balls result in free hit.
9. In a free hit, the batsman dismissal occurs only by a run out/stumping.
10. Bowling Action (Chucking): When a batsman / Captain of team objects the blower's action to be faulty and not in line with ethical bowling action, both umpires will monitor the action and take the decision either continue or stop the bowler to complete the over.
11. Once the match has started and stopped due to any reason, then that match will be continued on the same day in the available ground from where it was stopped. No re-match.
12. Captains should make sure that their team plays with good conduct and help to maintain the sportive environment on the field.
13. There will be no by runner for an injured batsman. He can retire for the inning.
14. Incase of a tie, Super over will be played. 1 over will be bowled and 2 wickets will be in hand.
15. Umpire decision will be the last decision.
16. In case of any conflict, the organizing committee has the right to disqualify any team for the misconduct.
