An F-1 or J-1 student who has obtained written authorization from an advisor in ISSS prior to (before) withdrawing from classes will be allowed a 15-day grace period for departure from the U.S. A student who terminates his or her course of study without prior approval or otherwise fails to maintain status is not eligible for any grace period and must depart immediately.
