

International Student Scholarships

By completing the scholarship application form on OrgCentral, you will be considered for all available scholarships. Please check the eligibility requirements for all of the scholarships, including the additional requirements for the Joe Tiao, Philip & Jeune Kirmser, Do Sup Chung, M& H Taiwan and Costa Rican International Student Scholarships.

The amount awarded and the number of scholarships awarded is contingent on funding. The following numbers are a projection and are subject to change dependent on the previously stated condition.

- OIP Scholarship for International Students: \$750
- International Student Center Scholarship: \$700
- K-State Alumni Association International Student Scholarship: \$500
- William L. Richter International Scholarship: \$500
- Philip & Jeune Kirmser International Student Scholarship: \$500
- Joe Tiao International Student Scholarship: \$500
- Do Sup Chung International Student Scholarship: \$500
- M& H Taiwan International Student Scholarship: \$500
- Costa Rican Student Scholarship: \$500

Deadline to apply: Wednesday, March 3, 2021 by 11:59pm

No incomplete or late applications will be accepted. The application also includes a K-State staff or faculty recommendation, which must be requested by the application deadline. The recommendation itself must be received by Wednesday, March 10, 11:59 pm. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Eligibility Requirements for all scholarships:

- You must be a graduate or undergraduate student properly enrolled at Kansas State University.
- You must not have received this scholarship during the previous academic year.
- Your current I-20 or DS-2019 must be issued by K-State.
- You must have been properly enrolled at K-State during the Fall 2020 semester or before.
- You must be continuing as a student at K-State during the Fall 2021 semester. The scholarship funding will be awarded to cover Fall 2021 tuition/fees. Students graduating prior to Fall 2021, are not eligible to receive this scholarship.

Additional Information for the Joe Tiao International Student Scholarship:

- Recipient must be from Taiwan.
- Preference is given to graduate students or exchange students.

Additional Information for the Philip & Jeune Kirmser International Student Scholarship:

- Recipient must be a non-resident undergraduate student.
- Preference will be given to students of African origin who are able to provide proof of citizenship from any country on the continent of Africa.

Additional Information for the Do Sup Chung International Student Scholarship:

- Recipient must be from Korea.
- Preference will be given to students from the Republic of Korea who have financial need, and show academic potential.

Additional Information for the M&H International Student Scholarship:

- Recipient must be an aboriginal Taiwanese student.
- Preference will be given to aboriginal students from the High Mountain people in Taiwan, or any other Taiwanese aboriginal tribes.

Additional Information for the Costa Rican Student Scholarship:

- Recipient must be an undergraduate or graduate student enrolled in any curriculum with financial need residing in Costa Rica.

Application Instructions

Step 1: Complete the online application form through OrgCentral. To access the application form click on the link below and sign in with your K-State eID and password. Once you have submitted your form, you will not be able to return to make any changes.

Step 2: Within the application form, you will be asked to identify a K-State staff or faculty member who can provide a recommendation on your behalf. Once you submit your part of the application, an email with a link to a recommendation form will be sent to your recommender from ISSS. The faculty or staff member will have until March 10, 11:59 pm to complete the online recommendation form through OrgCentral.

Remember, you must complete your portion of the application and identify your recommender by the March 3rd deadline. You are encouraged to apply early to allow plenty of time for your recommender to submit their recommendation form.

***Staff/Faculty Recommendation Forms received after 11:59pm, March 10, 2021, will not be considered, and your application will be denied.**

Step 3: Your application is considered complete once both you and your recommender completed the online forms through OrgCentral.

Step 4: Your application will be reviewed by a scholarship committee. All applicants will be informed of the committee's decision regarding their application during the last week of March.

(Note that OrgCentral will display "Status: Pending" until your recommender submits the required recommendation form on OrgCentral. Once the recommendation is received, OrgCentral will display "Status: Approved" and your application is considered COMPLETE. If recommendation is not received by deadline, OrgCentral will display "Status: Denied" and your application will be considered VOID. This is *NOT AN APPROVAL OR DECISION* on the SCHOLARSHIP AWARD. All applicants will be notified via email on the final decision of their application).

***Kansas State Scholarship Network (KSN) Applicants:** If you have submitted an application for the Joe Tiao, Philip & Jeune Kirmser, William L. Richter, Do Sup Chung, M& H Taiwan and Costa Rican Student Scholarships on the Kansas State Scholarship Network, you will still need to submit your application on OrgCentral as we need additional information from you.
