An F-1 or J-1 student who has obtained written authorization from an advisor in ISSS *prior to* withdrawing from classes will be allowed a <u>15-day</u> grace period. A student who terminates his or her course of study without prior approval or otherwise fails to maintain status is not eligible for a grace period and must depart immediately.
