

Early Departure Notice for International Students at K-State

IMPORTANT: Federal regulations require the university to report withdrawals. If you plan to withdraw from your courses or leave K-State prior to the end of your program, you must meet with your International Student Advisor at International Student & Scholar Services (ISSS) to talk about your plans and your immigration record. Once the form has been submitted and approved by your advisor at ISSS, you will be notified and then you may proceed with dropping your classes. An F-1 or J-1 student who has obtained written authorization from an advisor in ISSS *prior to* withdrawing from classes will be allowed a 15-day grace period. A student who terminates his or her course of study without prior approval or otherwise fails to maintain status is not eligible for a grace period and must depart immediately.

IMPORTANT IF EMPLOYED: Once you submit this form, you are no longer authorized to work or engage in any benefits approved for you based on your current F-1 or J-1 status.
