

Transdisciplinary Applied Learning Grant Application- Fall 2025 &

As part of Next-Gen K-State efforts, incentive grants are available as seed funds for the purpose of supporting teams to explore curriculum changes for a program which enhances Applied Learning Experiences. These grants help units to explore adding or enhancing Transdisciplinary Applied Learning in new or existing degree, certificate or micro-credential programs.

Funding range: A one-time award of up to \$20,000.00

Eligible to apply: Faculty member(s) with program chair and department head support.

Match: No matching funds are required, but applicants should demonstrate reasonable support for continuation three years beyond the grant period.

- File uploads for budget, timeline, letter of support, and abbreviated CV
- A project narrative
- Statements showing alignment with the ALE Framework
- Transdisciplinary statement (definition provided)
