| <i>Number & Amount</i> | 20 grants of up to \$1,500 |
| <i>Duration</i> | Depends on how quickly you spend it. |
| Eligibility | |
| <i>Who</i> | Active members of Phi Kappa Phi. Currently enrolled in a graduate program and conducting research or presenting research. Not a current Phi Kappa Phi Fellow and have not received a previous Dissertation Fellowship. |
| <i>When</i> | Enrolled in a graduate program. |
| <i>Selection Criteria</i> | Well thought-out proposal that demonstrates how it will contribute to your field and to the local, national, or global community as a whole. |
| Campus Deadline | None. |
| Deadline | November 30. |
| Application | Apply online. Application form. Summary of research experience being proposed. Must include an itemized budget for expected expenses. Statement regarding how it will impact your professional development and contribute more broadly. |
