

Phi Kappa Phi Study Abroad Grant

Purpose	From the website: <i>To help support undergraduates as they seek knowledge and experience in their academic fields by studying abroad.</i> One of several Phi Kappa Phi scholarship initiatives.
Award	
<i>Tenable</i>	Funds undergraduate study abroad in any country. Supports programs during the summer, fall and/or spring semester.
<i>Number & Amount</i>	75 grants per year (25 in Spring cycle and 25 in Fall cycle). \$1000 each.
<i>Duration</i>	Single payment.
Eligibility	
<i>Who</i>	PKP membership not required. No lower than 3.75 GPA. All majors are eligible.
<i>When</i>	Must be an enrolled undergraduate. Semester prior to study abroad.
<i>Selection Criteria</i>	Good fit between goals and planned program abroad. Strong academic record. Past winners from Kansas State have been quite diverse in their interests.
Campus Deadline	None.
Deadline	February and September deadlines. The application does ask for confirmation of acceptance by your program. However, the Study Abroad Office can document <i>anticipated</i> program acceptance if the program deadline follows the award deadline.
Application	Apply online. Application form. Essay that tells how your study abroad program relates to your future goals. Two letters of reference. Transcripts. Letter that confirms study abroad placement.
