I will be expected to prepare a journal-aiming article, a public-facing article, an abstract, and a presentation of my summer research. Program staff will assist me in preparing for these activities. I will also be expected to maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. There is no cost to me for participation in the activities or to receive services from the McNair Scholars staff.
