- Defining, Tracking, Communication
  - The team looked over edits to the overall definition, education abroad, and servicelearning.
    - Trish shared over proposed changes. Questions which surfaced were: How will we keep track of partners who lifted up a current experience within the survey? How do we honor past AL experiences without being exclusive?

    - Brent mentioned surprise at listings of education abroad opportunities which are domestic. The team discussed the differences between academic, professional, and personal skills gained by an intercultural immersion experience.
      - How scalable and prevalent are domestic experiences? If we recognize these experiences as educationally beneficial, we may need to consider how to recognize, track these. Would Study Away be an interesting model to consider?
