This position is a 12-month, full-time appointment and is benefits eligible. You will receive a salary of \$320,000 per year, at a bi-weekly amount of \$12,307.69 per pay period for 26 pay periods. Your appointment will begin on January 3, 2016 and run through June 4, 2016, or until the permanent Vice President for Research position is filled.

Your appointment will carry with it tenure at the rank of Professor in the Department of Chemistry. The administrative assignment is subject to change upon notice by the undersigned appointing administrator. When your term as Interim Vice President for Research has concluded, you will return to the position of Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences at your previous salary with any proportional salary increases received for merit or COLA.

As the Interim Vice President for Research and Chief Research Officer, you will be charged with providing leadership and expertise in fostering a campus environment that supports collaborative, interdisciplinary efforts and produces high quality research. You will be responsible for encouraging and facilitating the integration and enhancement of research activities across the university's colleges and multiple research centers and leading university-wide strategic research growth activities. In addition, you will provide leadership for the acquisition of research funding, the planning and development of academic research space, research commercialization, the incubation of new companies and recruiting of corporate research partners, and public outreach.

This appointment is offered in accordance with the provisions of our University Handbook, which is available online at: http://www.ksu.edu/academicpersonnel/fhbook. Your employment at Kansas State University is governed by the rules and policies contained in the University Handbook and by other policies adopted by the University.
