SUMMARY

The intent of this study tour is to acquaint students with the music, culture and history of Poland. Students will visit locations connected with Poland's greatest composer, Fryderyk Chopin. They will also learn about important historical and cultural aspects of communism, visit sites directly related to WWII and to the Holocaust, and study the impact of the WWII on this part of the world. Students' understanding of Eastern Europe will be further deepened as they experience the culture of present-day Poland. They will also attend musical performances. A certain amount of free time will be allocated into the itinerary for students to discover and learn more about other important cultural venues in this region of Europe.
