



## SFC Carlos Lane

Sergeant First Class Carlos Lane hails from Atlanta, Georgia. SFC Carlos Lane enlisted in the U.S. Army on 26 August 2004 as an 11B - Infantryman. He attended One Station Unit Training at 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 50<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment, 198<sup>th</sup> Infantry Training Brigade, Fort Benning, Georgia. His first duty assignment was with 5<sup>th</sup> Battalion, 20<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment, 3<sup>rd</sup> Stryker Brigade Combat Team, 2<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Division, Fort Lewis, Washington until May 2011. While there, he served in various duty positions to include Rifleman, Grenadier, Automatic Rifleman, Radiotelephone Operator, Squad Leader, and Assistant Operations Sergeant. In May 2011, he was reassigned to 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, 19<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment, 198<sup>th</sup> Infantry Training Brigade, Fort Benning, Georgia where he served as a Drill Sergeant. In May 2013, he was reassigned to 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, 87<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment, Fort Drum, New York where he served as a Heavy Weapons Section Leader and Antiarmor Platoon Sergeant. In February 2015, SFC Lane was reassigned to 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion 15<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery, 2<sup>nd</sup> Brigade Combat Team, 10<sup>th</sup> Mountain Division, Fort Drum, New York. While assigned, he served as a Platoon Sergeant for a Regional Force Protection Team in Afghanistan. Upon returning from Afghanistan, he was reassigned to the Fort Drum Noncommissioned Officer Academy in January 2016 where he served as a Small Group Leader, Chief of Operations, and Quality Assurance NCO. In January 2019, he was reassigned to Fort Riley, Kansas to the 1<sup>st</sup> Infantry Division G3 where he served as the Current Operations Noncommissioned Officer In Charge and Operations Senior Sergeant (Forward) in Poland. He was later reassigned as a Platoon Sergeant for a Mechanized Platoon in 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 18<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment, 2<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Brigade Combat Team, 10<sup>th</sup> Mountain Division in September 2020. He was reassigned as an Assistant Operations Sergeant for 2<sup>nd</sup> Brigade, 1<sup>st</sup> Infantry Division from September 2021 to March 2022. SFC Lane is currently assigned as a Military Science Instructor for the Kansas State University Senior Reserve Officer Training Corps, Kansas. SFC Lane has deployed twice to Irag in support of OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM and deployed once to Afghanistan in support of OPERATION FREEDOM'S SENTINEL and served on one EUROPEAN DETERRENCE MISSION in Poland.
