**This course is a comprehensive intermediate Japanese language course for those who have completed the elementary level. It provides well-balanced development of the four language skills – reading, writing, speaking, and listening – through study of the grammar, expressions, and strategies needed to communicate at the intermediate level. The program emphasizes active command of language, not passive accumulation of linguistic knowledge. Your goal is not to study the grammar and vocabulary of the Japanese language in isolation, but to gain necessary skills and develop the ability to use them in a way that is linguistically and culturally appropriate.**
