## What Can You Do With the Certificate?

The Certificate delivers knowledge and skills in core public health concepts, focuses on population-level health, and asserts that health and well-being are influenced by interactions among the social determinants of health.

## **Easy Application Process**

Eligible applicants must hold a bachelor degree (BS or BA) with a preferred GPA of 3.0/4.0 in the last 60 hours of coursework.

To apply go to the Graduate School's website: **k-state.edu/grad/**  Narrative Statement of Objectives describing education and public health experiences along with professional career goals.

**GRE scores** are requested if available (but not required).

**Copies of Transcripts** from each institution attended. If accepted originals must be sent.

**One letter** of recommendation from your supervisor.
