3. Discussion Items:

- The full cycle KBOR report was briefly discussed. If room, a comment concerning cooperation with new BS degrees in nursing and public health to create BS/MPH options for students. The report is in its final draft and will be sent to the CVM Dean for approval.
- <u>CEPH Interim Report due July 29, 2020</u>. There was an extended discussion about the report. All items were reviewed and the group felt the report was ready to be finalized. A final draft will be prepared with all attachments. Any additional comments will be set to Dr. Mulcahy for consideration. We will submit it to the CVM Dean before it is sent to CEPH. The report needs to address:

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- a) Defined appropriate assessment activities for foundational competencies 21 and 22. The report must include an updated version of Template D2-2 and all relevant syllabi and other documentation as needed. (Criterion D2)
 - #21. Perform effectively on interprofessional teams. CEPH comments were that this needs to be taught and assessed in a course. The updated assessment and syllabus were submitted by Dr. Hanson.
 - #22. Apply systems thinking tools to a public health issue. CEPH comments were that this
 needs to taught and assessed in a course. The updated assessment and syllabus were
 submitted by Dr. Mulcahy.
- b) Defined appropriate assessment activities for all competencies in the PHN concentration. The report must include an updated version of Template D4-2 and all relevant syllabi and other documentation as needed. (Criterion D4)
 - The Council found that the assessments for competencies PHN FNDH 844, #5; and PHN FNDH 600, # 1-4, do not fully address the competency statements.
 - The draft assessments were submitted by PHN, Dr. Rosenkranz indicated these are the final assessments and will submit the updated syllabi.
- c) Implemented policies and practices for the APE that ensure that all students demonstrate, and are specifically assessed on, attainment of <u>at least five</u> competencies. (Criterion D5). The updated MPH 840 syllabus was submitted by Dr. Mulcahy.
