It is understood that if your schedule does not allow for adequate rehearsal time, you may not be chosen to perform. Once you have committed to a dance, you are required to attend and arrive ON TIME to ALL scheduled rehearsals. If a dancer misses a rehearsal without previously securing the choreographer's approval, the dancer may be replaced at the discretion of the choreographer. If you decline a role in a dance for time-commitment related or other reasons, the faculty will make final decisions regarding the related casting changes.

Dancers must be available for each performance and dress rehearsal. As you will not be cast in every dance, you will not be working the entire listed Technical Rehearsal time. However, please make arrangements to have those times available. **Students will be released if they are no longer needed.** 

Your cast may also be required during the semester to participate in Community Outreach.

Enrollment in **Performance Production / Dance 502 (Fall 2025)** is required to students performing in **Winter Dance** and is available for 0, .5, or 1 credit. Secondary Majors in Dance and Dance Minors are required to have a minimum of 1.5 credits for their program of study.
