Learn to use "styles" in Word

"Styles" in Word

- A set of formatting characteristics that define the appearance of text in the document
- Font size, color, line spacing, indentation, numbering, space around the text, borders, etc.
- Styles are named and can be applied to portions of the document.
 - All chapter headings = "Heading 1" style
 - All 1st level subheadings = "Heading 2" style
 - All 2nd level subheadings = "Heading 3" style
 - All captions = "Caption" style

Why are Styles important?

- Your ETDR will be a "structured" document with chapters, subheadings, etc.
- Use Styles to format your document based on the structure
- Ability to change the appearance of your document while retaining the structure

How to Work With Styles

- Configure your computer to display the Style Area
 - the style used in each portion of the document.
- Turn on the Styles Pane a list of all available styles.
- Apply the appropriate style to each portion of your document.
- Modify styles as necessary to meet the requirements of your department or professor.



Images

- PNG and JPG images ok; don't use TIF
- Insert don't copy and paste
- PDF Save As JPG, then insert
- Resize images No larger than 650 pixels in width
- Free image resizing/reformatting software
 - IrfanView (www.irfanview.com) install
 - Shrink Pictures (<u>www.shrinkpictures.com</u>) online

Score Analysis Operations in Excel

- Add text to a cell
- Merge/Unmerge cells
- Draw a curve
- Draw crescendo signs
- Change line color and weight
- Insert an image
- Enter time signature
- Scale the sheet to fit on one page
- Show/hide gridlines
- Freeze panes
- Save as PDF



Final Formatting - PDF

- At the end of your Word document, create a blank page with the heading "Appendix A" (Style Heading 6).
- Save your Word document as PDF
 - Mac: If you have landscape pages, multiple PDF files will be created
- Save your Excel score analysis as PDF
- Use Adobe Acrobat Professional to combine multiple PDF files
- Filename: FirstnameLastnameYYYY.pdf
