

Accelerated Bachelor of Arts in Music/Master of Business Administration

Students that successfully complete this program will receive both a Bachelor of Arts in Music (B.A. Music) and a Master of Business Administration (M.B.A.) in an accelerated 5-year plan (147 credit hours). The application and admission process is the same as for the traditional MBA degree except that completion of the BA degree is not required. The following requirements must be met before an individual can be admitted into this program:

- The student must be seeking the Bachelor of Arts in Music degree at Kansas State University.
- The student must have completed 75-90 credit hours toward the B.A. degree.
- The student's cumulative undergraduate GPA must be at least 3.0.
- Students are responsible for researching financial aid implications of starting an accelerated degree program.
- A student who has completed all coursework for the bachelor's degree is not eligible for the accelerated program.
