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Application Process – Apply by May 1

Apply [here](#) or at www.campcamp.edu by **May 1, 2026**. Students who apply before the early bird deadline, **April 3, 2026**, will be eligible for a reduction of camp fees by 50% should their application be accepted.

Primary Track Selection

While filling out the application, students choose one primary track. This is the student's main focus during the camp; the area they spend the most time working on. The purpose of this track is to give students an opportunity to develop existing skills under the guidance of the world class K-State faculty and staff. Each primary track will culminate in a final public performance/presentation at the end of the week. The primary tracks offered are:
