

Bubba Carr's choreographic credits include films "Godmothered", "Lady and the Tramp", "Passengers", "Goosebumps", "Hunger Games: Catching Fire", "The Internship", "Bolden", TV shows "The Resident", "The Big Door Prize", "Ozark", "The Originals", "Halt and Catch Fire", "The Detour", "Drop Dead Diva". Stage "Cabaret", "Grease", "Carousel", "Evita", "Oklahoma", "Miss Saigon", "Hair", "Peter Pan", "Little Mermaid", "Titanic", "The Seagull", "Aida", "Oliver", "Jekyll & Hyde".

Bubba has danced and choreographed for Cher on four world tours, music videos and TV specials, has toured with Jane's Addiction and Porno for Pyros with lead man Perry Farrell multiple times, as well as Zac Brown Band. Currently Bubba manages Xcel Studios in Atlanta, GA, the premier studio for professional dancers in the south east.
