Goins writes regularly for *Living Blues* magazine, and is a feature columnist for Positive Feedback, PMA (Power of Music & Audio), and *Jazz Guitar Today* magazines, where he has written extensive articles and interviews on prominent jazz guitarists. Dr. Goins has published several biographical entries in *The Encyclopedia of the Blues* as well as the *Grove Dictionary of American Music*.

Dr. Goins is currently writing the definitive biography on the Grammy-Award winning blues musician Taj Mahal.
