Why Should You Join Band?

There are multiple benefits of being active in music while in school. Research has shown that students that are involved in a music group, such as band, are more likely to achieve in school, socially develop and succeed in society. Being in band teaches students discipline and responsibility through care and practice of their instruments, develop life long friendships, learn to work collaboratively through a large group setting and develop self-pride.

Instruments



Flute- The flute is part of the woodwind family. It is made out of silver or some type of metal. It creates sound by air being blown across a hole.



Clarinet- The clarinet is another member of the woodwind family. It is made out of wood or plastic. It creates sound by air vibrating a reed on the mouth piece.



Saxophone- The saxophone is another member of the woodwind family. It is made out of brass. Like the clarinet, it's sound comes from air vibrating a reed on the mouth-piece.



Trumpet- The trumpet is a member of the high brass family. It is made out of brass. Like all of the brass family its sound is produced by air causing the lips of the player to buzz.



French Horn- The French horn is the other member of the high brass family. It is made out of brass or nickel silver.



Euphonium- The euphonium is a member of the low brass family. It is made out of brass.



Trombone- The trombone is another member of the low brass family. It is also made out of brass and unlike the rest of the brass family it uses a slide mechanism instead of valves.



Tuba- The tuba is the biggest member of the low-brass family. It is made out of brass. It requires a large amount of air for it to create sound.
